

31 Scriptures to Pray over Your Husband's Technology

1. I will not set before my eyes anything that is worthless. (Psalm 101:3a) ~ *Help him choose things of value for his concentration and thoughts.*
2. Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer. (Psalm 19:14) ~ *May his words and thoughts please You.*
3. Therefore let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall. (1 Corinthians 10:12) ~ *Give him a humble, teachable attitude.*
4. Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting! (Psalm 139:23, 24) ~ *Please show him the private thoughts of his heart.*
5. Oh how I love your law! It is my meditation all the day. (Psalm 119:97) ~ *Give him love for Your truth and help him to think about it throughout the day.*
6. How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word. I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you. (Psalm 119:9,11) ~ *Help him to know, remember, and obey the truth of Your word.*
7. Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. (Ephesians 5:15-16) ~ *Show him how to use his time wisely.*
8. Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. (Philippians 4:8) ~ *Help him to choose to focus on these things.*
9. I will meditate on your precepts and fix my eyes on your ways. I will delight in your statutes; I will not forget your word. (Psalm 119:15, 16) ~ *Fix his eyes on your ways and help him love Your truth.*
10. "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God" (Matthew 5:8) ~ *Give him a pure heart.*
11. They have become callous and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedy to practice every kind of impurity. (Ephesians 4:19) ~ *Keep him from becoming callous to impurity.*
12. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. (Romans 12:2) ~ *Renew his mind daily so he will know what is acceptable to You.*
13. But know that the LORD has set apart the godly for himself; the LORD hears when I call to him. (Psalm 4:3) ~ *Set my man apart and cultivate his desire to call out to You for wisdom.*
14. The eye is the lamp of the body. So, if your eye is healthy, your whole body will be full of light, (Matthew 6:22) ~ *Help him choose to look at pure images that add to his good health.*
15. Turn my eyes from looking at worthless things; and give me life in your ways. (Psalm 119:37) ~ *If he is tempted to look at worthless things, make him want to turn away and find life in Your ways.*
16. Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord, and turn away from evil. (Proverbs 3:7) ~ *Help him fear You and look to You for wisdom.*

17. Put away from you crooked speech, and put devious talk far from you. Let your eyes look directly forward, and your gaze be straight before you. Ponder the path of your feet; then all your ways will be sure. (Proverbs 4:24-26) ~ *Turn his eyes straight ahead to sure ways.*
18. The way of a fool is right in his own eyes, but a wise man listens to advice. (Proverbs 12:15) ~ *Teach him to listen to godly advice.*
19. The eyes of the Lord are in every place, keeping watch on the evil and the good. (Proverbs 15:3) ~ *Thank You for Your constant watch over my husband.*
20. All the ways of a man are pure in his own eyes, but the Lord weighs the spirit. (Proverbs 16:2) ~ *Please weigh my husband's spirit and show him how to be pure in Your eyes.*
21. So flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart. (2 Timothy 2:22) ~ *Help him to flee temptation and to pursue righteousness, faith, love & peace.*
22. Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. (Psalm 51:10) ~ *Create a clean heart in him.*
23. Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. (James 4:8) ~ *Help him to be single-minded, desiring cleanliness.*
24. Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body. (1 Corinthians 6:19-20) ~ *Give him a desire to glorify You with his body.*
25. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. (Romans 6:12) ~ *Help him to be obedient with his passions.*
26. A man without self-control is like a city broken into and left without walls. (Proverbs 25:28) ~ *Teach him self-control that comes from your Spirit.*
27. For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control (2 Timothy 1:7) ~ *Grow his spirit of power, love and self-control.*
28. For this very reason, make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue, and virtue with knowledge, and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with steadfastness, and steadfastness with godliness, and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love. (2 Peter 1:5-7) ~ *Make him a man of virtue expressed in self-controlled godliness and love.*
29. Whoever walks in integrity walks securely, but he who makes his ways crooked will be found out. (Proverbs 10:9) ~ *If he walks in crooked ways, expose it; when he walks with integrity, bless him.*
30. Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak. (Matthew 16:41) ~ *Give him a desire to be a man of prayer.*
31. No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it. (1 Corinthians 10:13) ~ *When he is tempted, give him clear ways of escape and show Him Your faithfulness.*
