

10 Bible Verses to PRAY for SICK FRIENDS

But those who wait for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] shall change and renew their strength and power; they shall lift their wings and mount up [close to God] as eagles [mount up to the sun]; they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint or become tired. (Isaiah 41:31-AMP*)

Help my friend to wait on You, Lord, with the hope of renewal of strength, the ability to run and not be weary, and the promise to never again feel faint or tired.

Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord! (Psalm 27:14)

Give my loved one a heart of courage to wait on You in strength.

There is no soundness in my flesh because of your indignation; there is no health in my bones because of my sin. For my iniquities have gone over my head; like a heavy burden, they are too heavy for me. (Psalm 38:3-4)

Remove our sins far from us, O Lord, and take away any heaviness or oppression from offenses we carry. Restore health and soundness of flesh to the body of my loved one.

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:6-7)

We want to experience Your peace, O God, though we don't understand it. We need it to guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus and shield us from being anxious about anything.

And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:19)

You are able to supply every need, my God, and Your riches are more than adequate.
